



MEDICATION NOTICE FOR DIABETICS

The test you are having may interfere with your Metformin (brand names include: Actoplus, Avandamet, Fortamet, Glucophage, Glucophage XR, Glucovance, Janumet, Kombiglyze, Metaglip and / or Riomet) diabetic medication.

- 1. This notice applies only to the <u>Diabetic medications listed</u> <u>above</u>. You may resume all other medications as normal.
- 2. Do not take Actoplus, Avandamet, Fortamet, Glucophage, Glucophage XR, Glucovance, Janumet, Kombiglyze, Metaglip and/or Romet.
- 3. Do **not** resume your diabetic medications for 48 hours after your exam.
- 4. Increase your fluid intake for the next 48 hours to flush the barium and IV contrast from your system.
- 5. You may resume your normal diet immediately.
- 6. If you need a copy of your medical records or images, please provide a 48 hour notice to the medical records department.
